BIG HORN SHEEP\$8,500.00

This is probably North America's premier trophy. For this once-in-a-lifetime hunt, we guide on a one hunter to one guide basis. This is a pack in, high country horseback hunt. Each hunter will be provided a guide, camp cook, 100% effort and sheep country second to none. These hunts are extremely successful and are 10 days in length starting August 31 and running through October. Hunt dates are flexible.

SHIRAS MOOSE.....\$6,000.00

This hunt is on a one guide, one hunter basis with a camp cook provided. This is a pack in, horseback hunt that is 10 days in length with the season starting September 10 and running through October. Hunt dates are flexible.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN GOAT.....\$6,000.00

Wyoming has a good population of trophy billies in the 9" plus category. The Rocky Mountain Goat is one of the most beautiful trophies in the world and hunting takes place in some of Wyoming's most beautiful country. This is a horseback and foot hunt on a one guide, one hunter basis with a cook provided. The hunts are 10 days in length with the season starting August 31 and running through October. Hunt dates are flexible.

LATE SEASON AND SPECIAL UNIT TROPHY BULL ELK.....\$6,000.00

Lodging on our elk hunts vary from lodge accommodations, motels to basic wall tent base camps depending on the areas and seasons of your hunt. On this 7 day horseback hunt, you will experience one of the best elk hunts in North America. Hunt dates are flexible depending on area between November 1 – December 7th.

MULE DEER/ANTELOPE COMBINATION.....\$3,200.00

This is a trophy mule deer hunt for dark horned mountain bucks. We have one of the largest deer migrations in the country. Our hunters have enjoyed great success with nice 4x4 bucks and better. Our deer hunt is conducted out of our base of operations with comfortable lodge accommodations. We have some great antelope areas that are only a half hour from our base. These are limited quota areas and the odds of drawing are tough, but we encourage you to put in and if you draw, we know where to find trophy bucks. This is a one guide per two hunter hunt with the use of both trucks and horses. Hunt dates are: October 23 – 27; October 30 – November 3; November 6 – 10th.

MULE DEER.....\$3,000.00

This mule deer hunt as listed above, is a horse back hunt in the beautiful mountains and drainages of the North Fork and South Fork of the Shoshone River between Cody and Yellowstone National Park. This is a 5 day hunt and is conducted on a one guide, two hunter basis. Hunt dates are: October 23 – 27; October 30 – November 3; November 6 – 10th.

MOUNTAIN LION.....\$4,500.00

The ultimate fang and claw trophy!! We hunt the lion in several areas in the Bighorn Basin where our lion populations are outstanding. Success on these hunts is great with large toms being taken. Hunting methods include 4x4, foot, snow machines, 4-wheelers and dogs on a one hunter, one guide basis.

ANTELOPE.....\$1,500.00

If you have never hunted the "Ghost of the Plains", then you are due for a new type of adventure. This hunt is a lot of fun with great bucks to hunt in our areas. This hunt is one guide per two hunters with the hunt being three days in length. This hunt is based from town with the use of 4x4's and foot hunting. Hunt dates are flexible and start September 1st.

LATE SEASON COW ELK (Tag included).....\$1,900.00

If you want to experience a great elk hunt in the Rocky Mountains, but don't want to spend a lot of money, this is the hunt for you!! Lots of elk and great elk meat for the money with this horseback hunt. One guide per two hunters on this three day hunt during the late season from November 16 – December, you pick the three days that work the best for you. Success has been 100% most years and the licenses are generally easy to draw.

BOOKING INFORMATION

A deposit of 50% is required to book a hunt. Wyoming issues all licenses via computer drawing, but our hunters are basically guaranteed their mule deer and cow elk licenses. Since we strictly limit the number of hunters on any one hunt, we cannot refund a deposit. We will return your deposit promptly should you not draw a license.

LODGE HUNTS – All lodging, meals, guides, horses and equipment for the hunt are included in the hunt cost.

CAMP HUNTS – All lodging (tent, wood stove, cot, foam pad) meals, horses, guides and equipment included in hunt cost.

TOWN HUNTS – Guide, professional field care of trophies, transportation, private leases where applicable, sack lunches, and beverages are included in the hunt cost. Hunter is responsible for own lodging, breakfast and dinner in town.

THERE ARE NO HIDDEN CHARGES!!!

- **ANY TWO ON ONE HUNT CAN BE UPGRADED TO A ONE ON ONE HUNT FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$300.00 PER DAY.**
- **NON-HUNTING COMPANIONS ARE WELCOME ON MOST HUNTS FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$150.00 PER DAY FEE. EXAMPLE: FOR A TEN DAY HUNT, IT WOULD BE AN ADDITIONAL \$1,500.00 FEE REGARDLESS OF EARLY COMPLETION.**
- **PERSONAL ITEMS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MEAT PROCESSING, TAXIDERMY FEES, AIRFARE AND GRATUITIES FOR THE HELP ARE CHARGES BORNE BY THE HUNTER.**
- **GRATUITIES** – CLIENTS ALWAYS ASK, "WHAT? HOW MUCH? WHY?" Tips for your guides, cooks and wranglers have been a tradition for over 100 years. It is a way to show your personal appreciation for their extra hard work at making your trip a success. Standard gratuity is 10 – 15% of your hunt cost. This of course, is not mandatory and is only a historic tradition that you should base on the effort of your guide, cook, help, etc. making your hunt extra special and successful.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

- **ELK** - Application period is from January 1 – 31st.
- **DEER and ANTELOPE** - Application period is from January 1 – March 15th.
- **SHEEP, MOOSE and GOAT** – Application period is from January 1 – February 28th.
- **MOUNTAIN LION** – Mountain lion tags are available over the counter for \$362.00.

*** A \$12.50 conservation stamp available over the counter is required to hunt or fish in Wyoming.**

LICENSE APPLICATION INFORMATION:

We will handle and process all applications for our hunters.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS: Use the applications the Game and Fish or we have provided and fill in the upper section with your name, address, personal data, and use your social security number as your sport person ID number. Example: SP-123-45-6789. Be sure to sign the application. Next you must get either a money order or cashier's check made payable to the WY Game and Fish for the proper license amount. If you are not drawn, the WY Game and Fish will refund all but \$12.00 per license you have applied for. Once you have the application filled out properly and the check with the proper amount made out to WY Game and Fish, send it to us before the application deadline and we will fill in the area and type we feel have the best odds and will produce the best trophies for you. We will hand deliver the applications to Cheyenne for you.

ANYONE BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1966 MUST HAVE COMPLETED AND IN POSSESSION A VALID HUNTER SAFETY CERTIFICATE!!
